## Team Info

1. South Team Home/North Team Visitor
2. Limit of 25 players on a roster. Teams arrive in uniform.
3. North Team sits on bench at far end (right of score table)
4. Team-only restrooms will be available in the Ole Miss Rifle locker room.
5. All athletes on the roster will be announced with starting line-up announced last.
6. The warm-up clock will start 30 minutes prior to the game.
7. Scholar-athletes from each team will be recognized during pre-game ceremonies.
8. MHSAA will provide game balls. Teams furnish own balls for warm-ups.
9. Teams may enter the volleyball facility at 11:30am and floor will be available at NOON.
10. See attached map for parking and team drop-off instructions.
11. Post-game, runners-up will be awarded medallions and trophy, then MVP will be awarded followed by champions medallions, banners, and trophies.

### Gillom Athletics Performance Center

The University of Mississippi's Gillom Athletics Performance Center ranks as one of the nation's finest collegiate facilities. Located on Chucky Mullins Drive, the performance center (completed in 1997) underwent dramatic enhancements in 2010, adding additional grandstand seating and chairbacks. Before the 2017 season, the Gillom Athletics Performance Center underwent additional enhancements to the competition area, a weight room and expanded training room, and two video rooms for teams to watch film. Also include were upgraded locker rooms for rifle, soccer, softball, volleyball, in addition to visiting team locker rooms.

## OVERALL STADIUM POLICIES

Fans must conduct themselves in a manner that represents Ole Miss, the SEC and the NCAA with honor, dignity and respect. Specifically, fans must:

- Demonstrate qualities of civility and sportsmanship at all times.
- Not use harassing, obscene, lewd or lascivious language or fighting words at any time.
- Support the players, coaches and officials in a positive manner.
- Treat the visiting team, coaches and fans with respect at all times.
- Not become inebriated or belligerent.
- Refrain from entering playing and team areas at any time, including the conclusion of the game.
- Advertising or solicitation is not allowed unless approved by Ole Miss Athletics and IMG.
- Throwing of objects onto the courts is strictly prohibited.
- Smoking is prohibited on the University of Mississippi campus, including all areas of the stadium.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Artificial noisemakers
- Drones or other unmanned aerial vehicles are not permitted at Ole Miss Athletics venues.
- Pets
- Sticks/Poles (This includes pom-poms, pennants or flags on sticks. Pom poms are required to have paddle handles instead of plastic sticks)
- Strollers
- Umbrellas
- Unauthorized banners or signs larger than 8.5" x 11"
- Video cameras
- Any other items deemed hazardous by game operations personnel
- Bags that do not adhere to the clear bag policy
- Coolers
- Folding chairs
- Outside food & drink
- Any type of sporting ball or other throwing object
- Full face coverings
- Balloons, Signs with Glitter, Confetti

Ole Miss Athletics or any representative of the department reserves the right to immediately eject patrons that violate any of the above rules. These rules are subject to change at any time.

## ADA ACCOMMODATIONS

In accordance to ADA guidance, service animals are allowed in Ole Miss Athletic Facilities. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness at all times. No other animals are allowed in Ole Miss Athletic Facilities.

## CAMERAS AND VIDEOCAMERAS

All still cameras are allowed in the Gillom Athletics Performance Center. However, flash photography is not allowed. Please turn your flash off as to not distract the players. Video cameras are not allowed in the Gillom Athletics Performance Center without credentials issued by the Athletics Ole Miss Communications Office.

## **PARKING – FANS**

- No ADA shuttle will be provided.

## DIRECTIONS TO OXFORD AND OLE MISS

---

### Memphis International Airport:

- Exit airport to Winchester West to Airways -2<sup>nd</sup> light-turn left
- Follow to Shelby Drive- Take right
- I 55 South to Batesville
- Hwy 6 East to Oxford
- Two University Exits: Chucky Mullins Drive (formerly Coliseum Drive) and Old Taylor Road

### Nashville, Tennessee:

- I 40 West to Jackson, TN; Exit 85
- Bypass 70 through Downtown Jackson
- Hwy 45 –Left at the light downtown near the Conference Center
- 45 to Hwy 18- bears off to the right about ¼ mile past the McDonald's
- Hwy 18 turns into Hwy 7 at the Mississippi state line.
- Stay on Hwy 7 all the way to Oxford.
- Exit Hwy 7 to Hwy 6 West toward Batesville to access the University.
- Two University Exits: Chucky Mullins Drive (formerly Coliseum Drive) and Old Taylor Road

### Jackson, Mississippi:

- I 55 North to Batesville
- Hwy 6 East at Batesville exit
- About 25 miles to Oxford
- Two University Exits: Chucky Mullins Drive (formerly Coliseum Drive) and Old Taylor Road

### Birmingham, Alabama:

- I-20 West to 78 East through Tupelo.
- Take Oxford Exit and follow Hwy. 9 to Hwy 6 West.
- Follow Hwy 6 West to Oxford.
- Two University Exits: Chucky Mullins Drive (formerly Coliseum Drive) and Old Taylor Road
